Our Unique Approach to Accessibility



We encourage our leaders, members, elders, and volunteers to proactively address accessibility needs to the best of their ability by using the resources and methods available today, including making the Bible and God's teachings available in written , audio, and video formats that can be used on different devices today. Our online resources are accessible to everyone.

In addition, one of our Church Leaders, Daria Long, is disabled, so as someone who understands the personal struggles that a disability can create in daily life, we keep many items available at all times where we conduct church to help accommodate people with disabilities and who are in pain, including:

- Massage chairs, eye massagers, and neck massagers
- Back, neck, and arm braces to accommodate injuries in these areas
- Pain patches, pain creams and balms to anoint the body with earth's soothing herbs
- Neck support headrests and orthopedic pillows for lumbar support and for office chairs
 - Acupressure mats and pillows
 - Heating packs and therapy gel packs

We bring awareness of disabilities to all of our volunteers and we are always looking for new ways to improve and to become more accessible to more people, especially those with disabilities and injuries. We are embracing accessibility through thought and action.
